II. Facilities and other amenities at the Polytechnics:

- d. Civil Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering & Mechanical Engineering program at KPA and Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering program at GPK has been accredited by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA). The other Polytechnics are also pursuing for NBA accreditation.
- e. State of the Art Laboratories with smart classrooms and internet facilities.

III. Admission to Diploma courses in Government Polytechnics in Nagaland under Diploma Entrance Exams (DEE) for the academic session 2024-25

The Candidate must have passed HSLC examination with Mathematics and Science for Engineering (Civil Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering), for Architecture Assistantship & Interior Design passed HSLC/10+ with Maths, Science and aggregate of 55% or HSSLC/12+(Science) with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (PCM) and aggregate of 50% and for Fashion Technology (FT) a candidate must have passed HSLC. The candidates who have appeared HSLC/HSSLC during 2024 are also eligible to appear the Entrance test provisionally subject to fulfillment of terms and condition.

V. Pattern of the Admission Test

Subjects & Marking scheme:

The Diploma Entrance Exam (DEE) for Engineering Course shall be conducted through a single question paper as per the following details:

Mathematics	: 35 Marks
Science	: 35 Marks
English	: 15 Marks
General Knowledge	: 15 Marks

And for Diploma in Fashion Technology question paper will be

General Knowledge	: 35 Marks
General English	: 35 Marks
Maths	: 15 Marks
Science	: 15 Marks

All questions will be of objective type and each question carries one mark. Each question is followed by 4 alternative answers. The candidate will have to choose the correct answer and tick the appropriate choice of answer with blue/black pen. There shall be no re-evaluation or re-checking of answer sheet. The syllabus for the Diploma Entrance Examination (DEE) shall be that of Nagaland Board of School Education (NBSE) standard-X syllabus.

VI. Language of Question paper

The question booklet will be set and supplied in English.

Use of calculating devices/Phones/Written/Textual Material

Use of calculators, log tables and slide ruler, watches with facilities of calculator, pagers and cellular phones are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall. Candidates are also strictly forbidden from carrying any textual material printed or written, bits of paper, envelop or any other material into the Examination Hall except the admit card.

VII. Announcement of Results:

The DEE-2024 Provisional Merit list will be declared on **30.04.2024** and will be available on Department Website: (<https://dte.nagaland.gov.in>) and Notice Board (s).

VIII. Reservation Policy:-

- a. 15% reservation shall be made for Backward Tribes on the basis of One Tribe One Seat as per merit in the Diploma Entrance Exam (DEE).
- b. 10% of the total intake in all courses shall be reserved for Female Candidates.
- c. 5% special reservation shall be made for Differently able/Physically Handicapped students. The selection of students shall be made as per disability conditions prescribed by Medical Council of India/State in its notification in the regard.
- d. Out of the remaining seats, 90% of seats will be reserved for ST Indigenous of Nagaland and 10% of seats will be reserved for General Category against the following Courses: (**Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering and Fashion Technology**) except **Civil Engineering**.
- e. In the event, there are no takers from the above 1) 2) 3) & 4) categories, then the seats shall be de-reserved to ST Naga candidates belonging to the State of Nagaland.

IX. Procedure of Selection:-

1. Selection of Candidates is done on the basis of the result of Entrance Examination and also incorporating reservation policies of the State.
 - * The Entrance Examination will consist of one paper of 100 questions and carrying one (1) mark each, and question shall be of multiple choice type.
 - * Engineering/Architecture Assistantship/Interior Design stream: All Engineering/Architecture Assistantship/Interior Design streams shall have a common question paper and the question paper shall cover mathematics, Science, English and General Knowledge (G.K.), of standard-X, with mark distribution in the ratio of 35:35:15:15 (Maths : Science : English : G.K.)
 - * Non-Engineering stream Fashion Technology: Will have a separate Question paper and the question paper shall cover English, General Knowledge, Maths & Science of standard-X, with mark distribution in the ratio of 35:35:15:15 (English : G.K.: Maths : Science).
 - * G.K. shall also cover current national and international events.
 - * The syllabus for the Diploma Entrance Examination (DEE) shall be cover under Nagaland Board of School Education (NBSE) of standard-X Syllabus.
 - * In case of tie in the merit list a candidate be ranked higher on the basis of marks scored in Maths, Science, English of DEE-2024 and age for Engineering/Architecture Assistantship/Interior Design category. In case of tie in Fashion Technology the merit list a candidate be ranked higher on the basis of marks scored in English, General Knowledge, Maths and Science of DEE-2024 and age.
2. Selection of candidate to a Diploma Program will be done based on DEE-2024 merit list and availability of seat in the Diploma Program(s) of his/her stated preference (s).
3. Naga Indigenous inhabitants of the State shall be accorded first preference for selection. Thereafter, preference shall be accorded to children of non-Naga Indigenous inhabitant of the State, children of Non-Naga State Govt. Employees, Central Govt./Agency Employees serving in the State as per merit in DEE-2024.
