Selection of candidates to Agri & Allied courses, Medical allied courses through Common University Entrance Test-UG 2026

Meaning & Objective: As per merit score sheet of CUET-UG 2025, student applicant is selected and nominated to the various technical/professional courses of under-graduate study in Medical, Agri & allied degree courses.

The courses of study under the purview of CUET-UG (Nagaland reserved seats) for the academic session 2026-27 are:

1. B.Sc. Nursing
2. B.Sc. Agriculture
3. B.Sc. Horticulture
4. B.Sc. Fishery
5. B.Sc. Pharmacy
6. B.Sc. Forestry
7. B.Sc. Natural Farming.
8. B.Sc. Community Science.

Selection Procedure:

-There is a State Common Selection Board (SCSB) consisting of representatives from all user Departments.

-The Board conduct meetings and hold counselling sessions for selection and nomination of student candidates for admissions to various participating Colleges & Universities

-Selection of candidates is subject to:

1. obtaining the requisite percentage of marks (supported by marksheet) prescribed for the course.
2. the prevailing reservation policy of the state of Nagaland.
3. the merit score of the applicant (CUET-UG) as per merit List (approved by the SCSB).
However, the candidate must fulfil the eligibility criteria for the course of study.
4. the option being exercised by the candidate based on which the Nomination letter to the allotted seats shall be issued.
5. the general guidelines/Instructions provided by the Department of Technical Education from time to time.

Instructions & Guidelines

1. The prescribed application form for availing Nagaland State Reserved Seats through Common University Entrance Test (CUET) is made available at the office of the Directorate of Technical Education, Kohima (Below New Secretariate) or can be downloaded from the website of the Department of Technical Education.
2. The duly filled-in application forms should be submitted to the Directorate of Technical Education within stipulated time after which it will not be accepted.
3. Class 12+(Science stream) with Physics, Chemistry, Biology Passed, are eligible to apply for CUET-UG to avail the Reserved seats.
4. All requisite documents including Marksheet of the class 12+ (for those appeared students) HSSLC after the result declaration, should be submitted within specified time. Failing to do so, the applicant shall not be considered for selection.
5. Form fee ₹500/-shall be charged.
6. While filling up the form, applicant should carefully choose the name of the course in order of preference. Once the option is exercised and submitted, it cannot be changed. Overwriting is not permissible and will be termed "**CANCELLED**".
7. Incomplete application form shall be summarily rejected without stating any reason. The Department of Technical Education reserves the right to reject/cancel his/her candidature.
8. There shall be a last date for submission of forms. No forms will be accepted after the last date.
9. Applicants are advised to keep track of information/notifications in local media/ Directorate Office/ Website of the Dept.
10. All information/notification provided in the Local media/websites under the caption of the Directorate of Technical Education shall hold true and genuine and not otherwise.
11. An applicant who had been already selected/nominated/sponsored by the State Govt. for any study course in the past shall **NOT** be eligible for selection.
12. Applicant must fulfil the eligibility criteria of the course of study as required by the Institute/College/ University.
13. Declining of seat (already allotted) after a certain period of time, should not be practiced which may invite penalty.
14. Applicant may upgrade his/her option as long as vacant seat exists. Downgrading of preferred choices not permitted.
15. If CUET-UG result is declared after the last date of form submission, the CUET scorecard can be submitted separately within seven (7) days from the day of result declaration.
